, I am curious if anyone else has noticed a trend over the past year or so where people (I have nobody specific in mind) in the search marketing business seem to increasingly gravitate towards becoming a &ldquo;SEO celebrity&rdquo;. It&rsquo;s a bit like like moths to a flame, really. A while back, I had a search marketing job candidate answer the, &ldquo;Where would you like to be in 2-3 years?&rdquo; question with, &ldquo;I want to be a famous SEO&rdquo;. &ldquo;Why?&rdquo; I would ask. &ldquo;Because that&rsquo;s my goal&rdquo;. Fair enough, but it&rsquo;ll be tough to pay the bills with a wallet full of famous. An amazing number of people seem to think becoming well known in the search marketing business is an end in and of itself. Not seeing the forest for the trees, these folks put vast amounts of time into link bait ridden blogs, networking up and getting addicted to the rush of ego that comes from being recognized. Is it because they misunderstand reputation marketing or are they really thinking being a &ldquo;SEO celebrity&rdquo; is a bankable goal? The reality is, the benefit of getting a brand out there, whether it&rsquo;s a personal brand or a company brand, is to establish credibility and confidence in abilities to the target market. Becoming known is a stepping stone to achieving other goals like new clients, speaking gigs (especially paid speaking gigs), connections with marketing partners, talented

employees and other activities that generate business. Earning that business, delivering and being successful because of providing value is what earns a reputation. Establishing a well known brand and reputation in an industry is only worthwhile if there's something to back it up. Otherwise, all that is achieved is a hollow online existence requiring the constant feeding of "notoriety crack". I personally network enthusiastically and our blogging team has been known to write a few compelling blog posts from time to time. But there is a reason for it, a goal. It's not to be well known, it is to open doors for potential clients, employees or marketing partners to do business. Writing blog posts for the benefit of the industry and getting links from other SEO blogs is fine, but being able to write blog posts that consider the needs and pain points of your target audience and giving enough information to demonstrate your expertise while not completely giving the goods away to competitors is a skill worth developing. Make no mistake, if a potential SEO client has heard of a SEO consultant or agency from several credible source(s), then it can shorten the sales cycle to next to nothing. It can attract more desirable clients at better market rates. But there is a difference between being "that" guy or gal everybody knows but with little to back up the notoriety — ie clients/income and being the well known person/company that got there by consistently doing great work and attracting a premium client roster. Maybe it's really an issue of the "chicken or the egg" coming first. How is a new person/agency going to get clients if no one knows about them? Alternatively, how will anyone know about them unless they have some impressive clients to brag about? If that's the case, then I say blog on, network like crazy and get some business going. I'm curious if any readers have noticed the "need to be SEO famous" thing lately? Is it an issue or is it a good thing that gets more good content published and networking going on than otherwise would happen?., is a direct sales team for the social media space, and is able to get a first-hand look at the world of marketing through social media apps, a trend that is growing by the day. In fact, the company recently entered exclusive partnerships with six big-name social app companies — LivingSocial (on Facebook), Circle of Moms, Zynga, Serious Business, Where I've Been, and Poolhouse. I asked appssavvy CEO Chris Cunningham a few questions about the company's experiences with the industry that will hopefully shed some light on it for businesses looking to enter the social app marketing game.

Chris Crum: I see examples in the press release of companies that are "interested in" using the social media apps. Are these companies going through appssavvy?

Chris Cunningham: To date, appssavvy has run more than 75 campaigns between social media application developers and publishers with advertisers, including Lexus, Sony Pictures, ChapStick, Oakley and Adidas, to name a few. appssavvy connects advertisers and agencies with apps, such as the ones announced [the six partnerships mentioned above], among an array of others including NBC News's iCue, MesmoTV and SocialCalendar. appssavvy works with hundreds of applications. Where appssavvy fits is in that the company has relationships with advertisers and agencies and is connecting those relationships with developers of social media applications in contextually-relevant ways or through integrated sponsorships. Traditionally, a majority of these developers are just that, developers. They don't have the relationships with Madison Avenue, thus appssavvy fills the role as their advertising sales team.

Chris Crum: What are some specific examples of how these companies and other advertisers are using the applications to market? Where does the marketing fit into the "pick your five" app for example?

Chris Cunningham: appssavvy is focused on connecting advertisers to social media applications in contextually-relevant ways and through integrated sponsorships. It is not through traditional media buys of banners, etc. The campaigns are true partnerships where the advertiser is adding to the experience, not detracting from it. For example, Oakley, the sunglasses and other optical products outdoor company, this past winter ran a campaign on the social media application Snow Reports, providing snow reports at resorts from across the world. The

campaign was contextually-relevant, but Oakley also integrated custom skins, feature videos and profiles of the company's ski and snowboard teams. As for Pick Your Five, we do not have an advertiser example, yet, but stay tuned. Pick Your Five is not only hugely popular, but is a great entertainment opportunity for a brand.

**Chris Crum:** What exactly is appssavvy's role in the process of getting an advertiser's message out through these social applications?

**Chris Cunningham:** It ranges not only from connecting the two (social media application and advertiser), but from the creative standpoint, to the execution, to the tracking and optimization. appssavvy is the expert in this emerging space for digital marketers. We work with the agency and advertiser to create an opportunity in social media to reach relevant audiences, while adding to the experience. For example, recently we connected Sobieski Vodka with SocialCalendar. Sobieski's branding was integrated into the application's calendar and the premium vodka provided a martini glass icon — which was the most used icon during the campaign's flight — to be used in invitations. In addition, Sobieski also integrated recipes for holiday drinks into the application. In this example, Sobieski not only received strong branding exposure, but was able to connect with audiences that met its advertising needs.

**Chris Crum:** Can you give me any hard numbers involving conversion rates and/or click-through rates?

**Chris Cunningham:** It isn't about a click, although that metric is and can be tracked. In addition, each campaign is really different from a tracking perspective. Social media application campaigns, if done right, are not about traditional digital media of tossing up banners. We see them being right when done in regard to context. For example, would it make sense to connect an auto company with Circle of Moms? Probably, not. Would it make sense to connect a CPG company targeting moms? Absolutely. In addition to context, it is about integrated sponsorships. Oakley and Sobieski, as examples, not only fit from a context perspective, but they brought content that added to the experience and lifted their brands. From all of this, you can track any number of metrics, from how many videos or profiles were watched/viewed in the case of Oakley, to how many icons were used or recipes downloaded in the case of Sobieski.

**Chris Crum:** If there is anything else about appssavvy and social app marketing you'd like to share, please feel free to do so.

**Chris Cunningham:** A couple of things: First, social media applications are becoming mainstream. It always takes a year or two to garner enough understanding in the digital marketing space for an advertising opportunity to take shape. Since beginning appssavvy in early 2008, we've spent the better part of a year educating advertisers and agencies and are really starting to see the space takeoff. On that note, we're also seeing a real flight from quantity to quality, which is really what today's announcement of six new leading social media application partnerships is all about. Yes, there are tens of thousands of Facebook applications, but quality is winning out, which is very exciting and why companies like Circle of Moms, Zynga, LivingSocial, SeriousBusiness, Where I've Been and Poolhouse are experiencing such strong growth and success.

I'd like to thank Cunningham for answering my questions. I hope those who have not tested the waters of social media app marketing have gained some insight into the opportunities that are available.

Two years ago there was a bit of a media frenzy surrounding Goodmail's apparent arrangement with AOL; if you don't recall the exact players you might remember national news coverage of their spring 2006. Well, Goodmail's back with a new CEO and a new plan: certifying video email. Goodmail Logo, Currently, many email providers filter the complexities of code that make video in email possible, sending those files automatically the spam bin. The idea is the same as last time, with that video caveat: senders pay between one-tenth of a penny per message, perhaps up to a penny if the videos contain any advertising to go with them, to guarantee bypassing of provider spam filters. Once again Google is a chief holdout along with Microsoft. But those loudly alarmed last time could shatter some glass with their voices this time around because it's not just AOL on board with it. It's Yahoo, Verizon, AT&T, Time Warner Cable and Comcast. This half-dozen represent about 75 percent of inboxes. If a similar arrangement as the one with AOL in 2006, each provider gets a cut of the Goodmail cash. Yahoo is an interesting addition to an already notorious group of providers. Two years ago, they just played footsie with the plan, abruptly withdrawing their sensitive digits when water got too hot. The rest have never had any qualms about innovative ways to monetize their networks, nor qualms about upsetting everybody, including customers, in the process. It's hard to know what to make of Comcast's participation in conjunction with other odd news today that the cable company is Daily Candy, which targets women shoppers. Peer-2-peer sensitive detractors note that's another \$75 million Comcast isn't spending on network management, adding a network neutrality angle, an issue surprisingly part of this arrangement as well. But we'll get to that in a minute. Goodmail's new CEO, Peter Horan, argues at the (Sam Hansell authors) that this new authentication initiative could lead to automatic approval of other email application innovations. Imagine, for example, being able to make a purchase of a product without leaving your inbox. And a way to make a lot of money in the process by shaking down those who can pay for it. Currently, free service-provider whitelists have served this certification function, but likely ESPs aren't making any money directly by having them. This new incarnation of Goodmail adds that video word to differentiate between types of email a provider may want to send and/or block. In essence, this means text mail would always be free to send, and means those small businesses and non-profits—churches, charities, (pesky) activist organizations—will have the future equivalent of cardboard posters and markers with which to make their signs, and always a corner on which to stand and hold them up. But if you want to make a video and get lots of people to see it, well, just like always that will cost you a little (a lot) extra. After all, you could just, since links were left enabled the last time everybody threw a fit, just upload to YouTube and send a link for nothing. Goodmail and your friendly neighborhood ISP may also take a small cut of those donations—betcha, for PR reasons, they make concessions for non-profits, but no promises. This is where that surprising Network Neutrality angle comes in. The old issue of Goodmail carries again the old issue of special treatment for fat wallets. A Bits comment by George, by George, hits the mark on the very edge of the target: "I expect that at some point the free column I write and send monthly via e-mail will be summarily trashed unless and until I pay up, and when that happens, the column ends." "No, George, we've already established text will still be free to send. If you want to send out your new video column, that's where you'll run into filter trouble if you don't have the money to pay the troll toll. Horan himself brought up the tired old FedEx example used countless times by ISPs to justify their stances against Net Neutrality: "It is akin to saying there is U.S. Postal Service and there is FedEx," he said. "Some people can pay a premium to get a message to you sooner, in better style." It's a tired old example because it is a false analogy used to persuade tired old Congressmen who don't understand the Internet. There's no series of tubes, no dump trucks of data, no restraints of real-world physics, no planes, trains or automobiles or government (in)efficiencies and budgets involved. Comparing Goodmail to FedEx is also a big mistake. It's a trigger to launch a whole world of passionate agenda setters onto Goodmail again, and it mimics telecoms' and cable companies' arguments for a tiered Internet nobody wants except those who expect to profit immensely from the tiers. The FedEx argument already failed because it's not the same thing. Why bring it up again? Sam Hansell found a hole in it pretty quickly, too, by mentioning the postal service doesn't sift through his mail to throw out 95 percent of it before he gets it. But again we have a false analogy. First, postal service costs money and that is the chief reason one doesn't get a thousand times more junk mail at home. Second, ESPs are expected to filter out junk mail as a customer service. What we're looking at instead—if we want to keep this tired old analogy—is that the US Postal service has access only to Interstates that are partially blocked, meaning that they can't always make it to where they want to go, while special underground high-speed pay tunnels provide smooth sailing to any destination. What we're looking at is FedEx putting the Postal Service out of business entirely. That makes Goodmail a full-fledged Net Neutrality issue. That makes Goodmail the sole

arbiter of who gets to a cabal of providers. That makes it easier for providers (all of whom deal in video distribution these days) to block out user-generated competitors. That makes the wave of the future—Internet video message distribution—firmly in the grip of a few corporations. That makes it one more step toward your next step, your next pivot, one you have to pay for. You want the truth? Spam is actually a small price to pay to keep email free.
